CAFE 1927 will embark us on a reminiscence journey throughout the effervescent artistic Paris and cosmopolitan New York in 1920s-1930s with a musical chain of influences including works by Gabriel Fauré, Maurice Ravel, Ralph Vaughan Williams, George Gershwin and Astor Piazzolla.

Three months in 1908 resulted as an enriching friendship and musical exchange for both Maurice Ravel and Ralph Vaughan Williams, the first proudly calling the second his pupil. While back to 1897 Maurice Ravel was enrolling in Gabriel Fauré's composition class...some years later Porgy and Bess will be sounding in Broadway and even years later Astor Piazzolla will bring a 'Nuevo Tango' to audiences, binding jazz and classical music influences.
